Clarence Regional Library invites Bundjalung, Gumbaynggirr, and Yaegl members of our community to get creative with their library.

Did you know? Clarence Regional Libraries' Aboriginal Collection features printed books (fiction & non-fiction), DVDs, e-books and audiobooks, ephemera, records, artworks, photographs, and access to online resources through our libraries website.

In 2020, we are excited to invite our Aboriginal community to submit their art or design to help promote this important collection.

Entry into this competition **opens** on Close the Gap Day 2020, Thursday 19th March and **closes** at 4pm Friday 29th May 2020 (Reconciliation Week)

- There is no age limit on entry entries from all ages are welcomed.
- Only one entry per person may be submitted.
- Artworks or designs must be either easy to be photographed/scanned or can be submitted in a digital format.
- The winning work/s will be used in the library's promotional material of its Aboriginal Collection.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entry

Entry is free for Bundjalung, Gumbaynggirr, and Yaegl residents of the Clarence Valley. One entry per person may be submitted.

2. Submission of Entry

The completed entry form and artwork must be submitted by 4:00pm Friday 29th May 2020. Artworks or designs can be delivered to your local Grafton, Yamba, Iluka, Maclean or Mobile Library. Digital entries (including electronic photographs of artwork) may also be submitted by emailing your entry to iane.kreis@clarence.nsw_gov.au

The artist is responsible for the delivery to, and collection of, their entry to the relevant library.

3. Insurance

The Clarence Regional Library and Clarence Valley Council accepts no liability for loss or damage during transit and exhibition. You may consider taking out insurance for your work.





4. Labelling

All works must be clearly labelled on the back of the work with the artist's name, title of work, medium, year and a directional arrow and/or word. EXAMPLE: John Smith - "Always Was. Always Will Be." - Acrylic on Canvas - ↑ TOP

5. Selection and Judging

A panel comprised of representatives from Bundjalung, Yaegl and Gumbaynggirr nations will view each entry and select the winning works. All entries may be displayed by Clarence Regional Library from the end of May to the end of July 2020. The Judge's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. The winning work/s selected will be used as part of Clarence Regional Library's Aboriginal Collection's promotional material including, but not limited to, fliers, posters, banners and online design.

6. Results and exhibition

The competition winner will be notified and announced by Friday 19th June 2020.

7. Sales and commission

Clarence Regional Library cannot sell artworks or designs.

8. Return of Artworks

Submitted artworks will be available for collection from Grafton Library from 10am on Monday 17th August to 12pm on Saturday 5th September 2020. Delivery to other libraries or via mobile library must be arranged prior to 5th September 2020 by contacting Jane Kreis on 6641 0121 or jane.kreis@clarence.nsw.gov.au

9. Promotion

Clarence Regional Library reserves the right to reproduce any works entered into the competition for archival, catalogue or publicity purposes. The signed entry form is evidence of the artist's consent.
