Meetings provide an opportunity for the FOL to plan events, determine how they help in library projects and hear an update on news from the library team.


The meetings are to be held at the Maclean Library at 2pm and the Sir Earle Page Library and Education Centre in Grafton at 4pm – both on December 4.
