Exposing your neighbourhood stories in History Week

ORAL historian, Benjamin Thorn, says everyone has at least one good story and he'll be in the Clarence Valley during History Week to help people bring theirs out.

Pursuing the theme Neighbours, Dr Thorn will discuss using oral histories as a tool for contextualising history.

He says talking to neighbours can be a useful way to gain insights into local history and through personal experiences gain an understanding of wider historical events.

Regional librarian, Kathryn Breward, said the visit would help people explore the historical stories of their neighbourhood.
