Bellingen Shire Council celebrated Harmony Day on Monday 21 March 2016 with a morning tea held in the Bellingen Library.

Popular local singer songwriter Yhan Leal delighted the audience with his musical soundtrack throughout the morning.

An enthusiastic crowd listened while the Bellingen Shire Mayor, Cr Mark Troy acknowledged the traditional custodians of the land and then spoke about the importance of celebrating Australia's cultural diversity, inclusiveness and promotion of a sense of belonging for everyone.

It is a day of cultural respect for everyone who calls Australia home – from the traditional owners of the land to those who have come from many countries around the world. By participating in Harmony Day activities, we can learn and understand how all Australians from diverse backgrounds equally belong to this nation and enrich it.
